Hot Tubs and Swim Spas

CHEMICAL MAINTENANCE CHEAT SHEET



Check chemical levels at least 2-3 times per week

1. Alkalinity

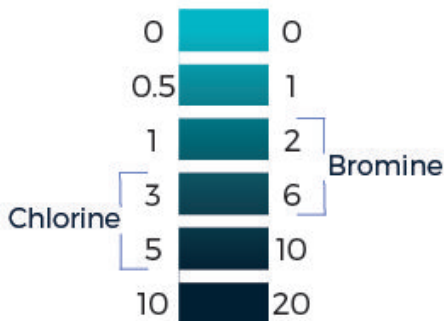
Adjust alkalinity first as it affects your hot tubs pH levels. This should be between 100 - 150 ppm.

Add sodium bisulfate to lower alkalinity or sodium bicarbonate to increase alkalinity levels.



2. Sanitise

Add a chlorine or bromine tablet floater, reducing the frequency you will need to add granular forms of sanitiser.



Maintain a level of ppm

3. pH Levels

pH levels are important to be kept at the correct level to ensure sanitiser can work effectively and to prevent any skin/eye irritation.

Add sodium bisulfate to lower pH or sodium carbonate to raise pH levels.
